


## LEGEND



<ul> <li>General Notes:</li> <li>1. Refer to Architectural Drawings by others for all items aside from the planting plan, including but not limited to Site Preparation and protection, erosion control, grading, utilities, lighting, geotech, limit of work restrictions around the ciritical</li> </ul>
<ol> <li>line and buffers, etc.</li> <li>The Contractor shall call for utility locates, verify utility locations and notify the Owner of any conflicts of the plan</li> </ol>
<ul><li>prior to commencement of work.</li><li>3. Existing trees to be protected before commencing work and chall be maintained through the duration of construction.</li></ul>
<ul> <li>shall be maintained through the duration of construction.</li> <li>4. The location of plants in the Drawings is diagrammatic. Before planting, the Contractor shall stake all woody plant material locations and plant bed extents for review and acceptance by the Owner. The Owner may rearrange or relocate plant material on site.</li> </ul>
<ol> <li>Prior to ordering materials, Contractor to verify all dimensions and quantities and shall notify Owner of and discrepancies. In case of discrepancy, the graphically shown quantities of trees and shrubs shall take precedence.</li> </ol>
<ol> <li>All work shall be conducted in accordance with national, state and local code.</li> </ol>
Planting Notes:
<ol> <li>Plant material shall be healthy specimens free from disease or damage, and is to be maintained in excellent condition while on the jobsite.</li> </ol>
<ol> <li>All plants shall be typical of their species or variety with normal habit of growth.</li> </ol>
<ol> <li>Provide matching sizes and forms for each plant of the same species unless otherwise indicated.</li> </ol>
<ol> <li>Set finish elevation of plant beds (top of mulch) 1" below adjacent hardscape.</li> </ol>
<ol> <li>All plant material shall conform to the guidelines established by the current American Standards for Nursery Stock, published by the American Association of Nurserymen.</li> </ol>
12. All root wrapping materials shall be removed from the rootball. Rootballs and containers shall be free of weeds.
13. Do not make plant substitutions.
<ol> <li>Plants shall be placed per plans. Groundcovers to be organized with triangular spacing.</li> </ol>
15. Landscape Contractor to guarantee all work and plant material for a period of one (1) year from date of final project acceptance by the Owner. Replace all defective work with new material of the same species, size, character and quantity as originally accepted.
16 Do not prupe plants before during or after installation unless

17	All nowly roars

 All newly regraded or disturbed areas shall be revegetated.
 Seed mixture and fertilizer shall be applied per the requirements of the governing jurisdiction.

19. All seed must be certified weed free. No seed shall contain any species on the City, County, or State noxious weed lists. Only seed with a complete analysis and germination test on bag shall be used.

### Irrigation Notes:

Irrigation shall be provided by the Landscape Contractor to all proposed planting material (including lawn area) shown on plans. Irrigation plans shall be provided by the Contractor to the Owner for approval prior to installation.
 Irrigation shall meet all Charleston County zoning requirements and specifications.

### Soil Notes:

Mulch

22. Landscape Contractor shall provide Owner approved topsoil for all planting beds. Topsoil shall be free of subsoil, stones, organic debris, or any extraneous matter.

23. Six (6) inches of topsoil shall be provided for all lawn and native planting zones.24. Eighteen (18) inch plant mix shall be provided for all plant

beds.
19. Provide and apply soil amendments as required to meet healthy soil chemical properties. Soil amendment organic matter shall consist of either Class I or Class II compost.
20. Soil shall not have herbicides, heavy metals, biological toxins

or hydrocarbons that impact plant growth or exceed the EPS's standards for soil contaminant.21. Fine grade all areas to be smooth, free draining, even surfaces with fine texture. Roll, rake and drag areas to flatten

ridges and fill depressions. Control moisture content to maintain optimum conditions and do not create muddy conditions.

22. Contractor to provide 3" of shredded organic hardwood mulch around all plant material. Around all trees & B&B shrubs, create a 4" high soils saucer at each tree pit to taper to zero inches at the rootflare Do not place mulch against the plant stem/trunk.
